

## PRE-TEACHER CANDIDACY CLINICAL GRADING REQUIREMENTS

The following activities must be completed by all students desiring credit for Clinical Work.

- Final Reflection Clinical Paper
- Professional Completion of Clinical

(This includes, but is not limited to, completion of all hours/activities, proper documentation of the clinical experience, attitude, responsibility, preparation, and delivery of lessons, etc.)

Grades for clinicals will be determined according to the following rubric ( **Note:** Late submittal of any of the items listed will also factor into the grading per professor’s policies.):

A	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The student thoroughly completed all assignments and forms according to directions.</li> <li>2. The student finished the clinical/assignments by the designated date. This includes submitting all clinical paperwork when due-Experience Log, Participation Verification, Interview Verification (<b>if clinical description requires it – check with your professor to see if required</b>), Lesson Self-Evaluation, CT Evaluation, and College Supervisor Evaluation. Note: Evaluation by College Supervisor may be absent due to schedule conflicts but every attempt should be made to get a lesson evaluated by a college supervisor.</li> <li>3. The student communicated clearly and in a timely manner with school personnel.</li> <li>4. The student conducted himself/herself in a professional manner at all times.</li> <li>5. The student demonstrated an <u>above-average</u> skill in writing a reflective analysis of his/her teaching practice.</li> <li>6. The student demonstrated an <u>above-average</u> skill in teaching the lessons asked of him/her.</li> </ol>
AB	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Numbers 1-4 (A level) above are fulfilled.</li> <li>2. The student demonstrated an <u>average</u> skill level in writing a reflective analysis of his/her teaching practice; and/or</li> <li>3. The student demonstrated an <u>average</u> skill level in teaching lessons.</li> </ol>
B	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Numbers 1-4 (level A) above are fulfilled.</li> <li>2. The student demonstrated a <u>below average</u> skill level in writing a reflective analysis of his/her teaching practice; and/or</li> <li>3. The student demonstrated a <u>below average</u> skill level in teaching the Junior Achievement lessons.</li> </ol>
F	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Failure to complete any or all of numbers 1-4 (level A)</li> </ol>
I	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Incompletes will only be awarded in cases of serious illness or emergency.</li> </ol>
